Phonics: onk in honk, unk in trunk, wa in wash, a in adopt, y in baby, and le in little
Language: A long word may be divided between a vowel and a consonant. If the vowel comes at the end of the syllable, it is usually long.
Reading: **Homework: Mon., Tues., and Thurs.**
Spelling: **New spelling homework is due on Tuesday.**
Spelling test is on Friday.
Math: Introduce the thermometer
Before and after numbers by ones (101-150)
Introduce telling time to the half hour
Introduce finding the greatest of 3-digit numbers
Homework: Flashcards on Tuesday and Thursday
