

# <u>Grades</u>

Students are given a grade on tests only, which will be updated weekly in FACTS. Their graded papers will go home in their red folders and tests in the blue Tuesday folders. You always have access to their grades by logging into FACTS.

Report cards are issued at the end of each quarter. There are two scheduled times for Parent-Teacher conferences during the school year. These times are at the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> quarters. However, a conference may be scheduled by a parent or teacher at any time. Please feel free to call and schedule a conference if needed.

# **Water Bottles**

Please bring a water bottle with you daily. We will not be using the water fountains, but we have a water bottle refill station. I will have them take the bottles home every day.

#### Snacks

The students will have a snack daily. I have decided it would be easier to do bulk snacks. What I mean is, BIG boxes of like granola bars or BIG boxes of individual bags or big box of crackers, applesauce pouches, fruit cups, box of gogurt, bulk yogurt covered raisins etc....this way we have the snacks already in the room and I

won't stress because I forgot to send home the snack basket and you won't stress because you forgot until the morning drive to school! We have access to a refrigerator and freezer, if needed. Please try to send healthy-ish snacks; we will save the sweets for parties and birthday celebrations.

## **Classroom Parties**

First graders love to celebrate! Please feel free to bring treats to share with the class on your child's birthday. If your child has a summer birthday, they can celebrate in May, or we can set up a ½ birthday! (like if their birthday is July 5<sup>th</sup> we could celebrate Dec. 5<sup>th</sup>)

We will have 3 scheduled parties this year. You will receive more information about these parties as we get closer to the dates. We would love your help celebrating, however we are limiting the amount of people that can come so please, only the parents that have signed up for the party may attend.

## **Classroom Management Plan**

All students are expected to obey and exhibit appropriate behavior in the classroom. If a student is misbehaving, I like to use positive reinforcement first. For example, if one student is playing in line, I will say, "I love how Jill and Bob are quietly standing in line."



Normally, the misbehaving student will follow the example of those that were praised.

If a student has been warned and continues to misbehave, they will lose recess minutes. If they continue they will see Mrs.C. If negative behavior continues, I will talk to parents/guardians.

I am also using a class reward system. When I get a good report from one of the specials teachers, substitute teacher or the class, as a whole, has done well working together to follow directions, they will earn a "warm fuzzy". When they have a jar full of "warm fuzzies" they will receive a doughnut party for snack or pizza party for lunch or whatever we have decided on as a class.
