


4-5th Grade Handbook 2025-2026


Welcome to Fourth/Fifth Grade!

-Policies & Procedures-

- **Discipline/Classroom Management:** This year, since we only have 4 students in our classroom, I don't anticipate having much trouble at all. However, if I have to get on to them for any reason, 1. Will be a verbal warning, 2. Will be missing/walking at recess, 3. Will be writing a verse out of the Bible, 4. The students will be require to write a note home to the parents explaining the action, parents will sign it and send it back, 5. Talking to the principal.

Our class rewards will be popcorn Fridays. Every week that goes smoothly and without disciplinary action, we will have popcorn during Friday afternoons. If you would like to donate something else (if your child gets tired of popcorn, for example), feel free to send suggestions and replacements.

Please remember we are a Christian based classroom, so that means we will correct in a Christ-like loving way, and pray with each other.

- **GroupMe:** I will be using the mobile app "GroupMe" to communicate with each of you throughout the year. I will send updates and reminders, and also, post pictures of things we are doing in class. Please make sure you are signed up, so you don't miss out on anything.
- **Homework:** Students will be expected to read 250 pages each month. They will be keeping a reading log so that we can both keep track. I will make this a grade each month, so please make sure they are reading at home. The students will also have occasional homework if they do not finish their work in class. They will need your help studying for quizzes and tests throughout the year.
- **Communication:** I love how much each of you care about your child's learning, however, this year I am asking that all school-related communication goes through GroupMe. I have set "office hours." That way you know when I will be able to answer questions. Those are going to be

Monday-Friday 8:30 am until 5 pm. If it is an emergency, please let me know. Each of our parents are FANTASTIC, and chances are another parent might know the answer to general questions, so please feel free to ask them. If you need a copy of a study guide, a memory verse, or spelling words, someone has one and will send you a copy.

- **Class Descriptions, Test, & Quizzes:** All test and quizzes will be announced in class ahead of time and will be included in my weekly note.
- **Spelling:** We will start a new list and test on Tuesdays. Each list has four workbook pages, that we will go over on Wednesday. They will be due the next Monday, before we take the test on Tuesday. If they don't get the pages done in class, they will need to finish them at home.
- **Math:** There will be a math assignment daily. I will do my best to give them enough time to complete them in class. If they do not finish, it will be homework and needs to be turned in the next day before chapel.
- **Language:** Students will be completing daily language assignments; they will occasionally have homework. You should be able to look at the material we have been going over that week to know what will be on the test. Please, please look through your child's papers to know what they need to work on.
- **Reading:** At home reading will be a part of your child's reading grade. We will be doing book reports throughout the year. I ask that this, along with everything else, be the students' work. Students will also be doing reading and have workbook pages assigned.
- **History:** Students will have a test for each chapter. It will be announced in class several days ahead of time. You will get a mid-chapter review sent home in their folder, and you will get an end of the chapter review the day before a test. The mid-review might have some information that the ending review will not. Please start reviewing as soon as you get the review papers, it will make everything easier. We will also be memorizing all 50 states and capitals sometime in the year. There will be a separate paper sent home with all the test dates.
- **Science:** Students will have a test for each chapter. The chapter study guides and quizzes are randomly placed throughout the workbook, so when we come across them, they will place them in their folder. The last workbook page will always be the main review.

- **Bible:** In fourth grade the students are expected to fill out their own study guides and review them at home. This will have information that they will need to know for the test. You can start studying it as soon as you get it. There will be a verse test every other week, and a unit test on the other. Please help them study.
 - **Redos:** Students may redo assignments with a grade below a 70%, however, they will only receive 50% credit for the corrected questions. Any redos will come home with the stack of graded papers in the Tuesday folder each week. Redos are due before chapel that Friday. There will NOT be any redos on test or quizzes.
 - **Late papers:** I will take late papers up to 4 days past the due date. However, for everyday it's late I will take 5 points off. I will also take 5 points off if a student forgets to put their name on their paper.
 - **Field Trips:** We will take at least one field trip each nine weeks. The first one will be to Roll School.
 - **Class parties:** You will be required to sign-up and help with one or more class parties at the first Parent/Teacher Conference.
 - **Christmas Party:** December 19, 2025
 - **God's Love Party:** February 13, 2026
 - **Resurrection Party:** April 2, 2026
 - **Birthday Parties:** Each student will receive a special blessing in chapel on their birthday. You may bring a treat for the class if you would like, I will get in touch with you to decide a day and time. If your child has a summer birthday, we will pick a day that works for everyone.

Please note that all of the above is subject to change at the teacher's discretion; however, if something changes, I will let you know in a note. Thank you for all your support.
