I will send a folder home each day with the day's work. Some days there will not be any papers. This folder needs to be returned each day.

PARENT/TEACHER CONFEREIENCES

Parent/Techer conferences will be October 6 and March 8. You will be contacted prior to this date with your conference time. At this time, we will discuss your student's progress and expectations and expected skills throughout our school year.

DISCIPLINE PLAN

I have a discipline and reward system in the classroom. Each student has a sticker chart on their desk and three sheep, green, yellow, and red.

For Reward they receive stickers for good behavior in the classroom, lunchroom, special classes and recess. This includes following class rules and being polite and helpful to classmates. Once the child has 5 stickers he/she can get a treasure out of the Treasure Box.

For discipline each student has a green, yellow and red sheep on their desks. They are learning and growing each day and I will redirect them as a first form of behavior change and they will give me their green sheep. If the behavior continues, they will give me their yellow sheep and sit out 5 minutes of recess. If the behavior doesn't resolve, they will speak to Mrs. Miller and you will be contacted. The sheep will be replaced each day.
