

DISCIPLINE PLAN

We will utilize a clip up/down behavior chart in class. Each day the child is in a 'Ready to Learn' clip, depending on actions, they will be clipped up for positive behavior, or down for negative behavior/choices. Each child will have the possibility of moving up or down throughout the day as they make choices. If a child is clipped up on "Great Choices" throughout the whole week on Friday, he/she will get to choose a prize from our treasure box of their choice before dismissal. If a child is clipped down for negative behavior, then I will choose a prize for his/her student before dismissal.


WATER BOTTLES/BLANKETS

Every Monday your child will need to bring a water bottle with their name on it and a blanket for rest time. Please

This folder needs to be returned every day.


PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCES
