Bible — Our new unit for this week is entitled: “Paul and the Thessalonians-Submitting to God” Unit 10. Romans 17:1-9 and 6:5-14. Memory verse is Romans 6:12-13. Bible memory verse is scheduled for Friday.

Math — Lessons 75-78. Quiz 16 will be held on Monday. Covering subjects such as naming solid shapes, story problems, cross multiplication of fractions, Test 8 is scheduled for Thursday January 22. Students will be tested over, writing fractions, parts of a whole, cross multiplication, story problems, division with fractional remainders, measurement equations, rules of divisibility.

Language — Lessons 92-95. A quiz will be given over, antonyms, synonyms, homonyms, pronouns & antecedents on Tuesday. A language test review will be conducted on Wednesday for a language test 94 on Thursday. Students should show aptitude in guide words in the dictionary, dictionary skills, pronouns & antecedents, synonyms, antonyms and homonyms. Students should be able to distinguish between fact and opinion, subject and verb.

History—Lessons 67-70: This week, students will receive a study guide on Tuesday for the chapter 4 test. They will work on their state notebook, focusing on Kentucky, and should be able to identify northeastern and southeastern states and their capitals.

Science Lessons 109, 110, 111, and 114: This week, we'll start the “Sound” chapter. There will be two short quizzes—Quiz 11a covers vibration, sound, and scientific terms; Quiz 11b is about sound travel. We plan to dissect an eyeball, and students are to build a human eye model, due Wednesday, with online examples provided.

Spelling — This week covers Spelling List 21. Final test will be given on Friday with a pre-test on Thursday.

Reading Students will begin Novel Studies with the book "Sarah, Plain and Tall." Preparations for the upcoming speech contest scheduled for January 29th will also continue. Parents are invited to attend and observe their children deliver speeches in the classroom on that day. Judges will be present to assess each student's performance and presentation.

Students are working on speech memorization and delivery. This week, we'll celebrate 100 days of school—students should bring their collection of 100 items. Please ensure your child reads at home and completes book reports. For this semester: 300 pages earns an “A”, 250 pages a “B”, and under 250 is a “C” or lower.
