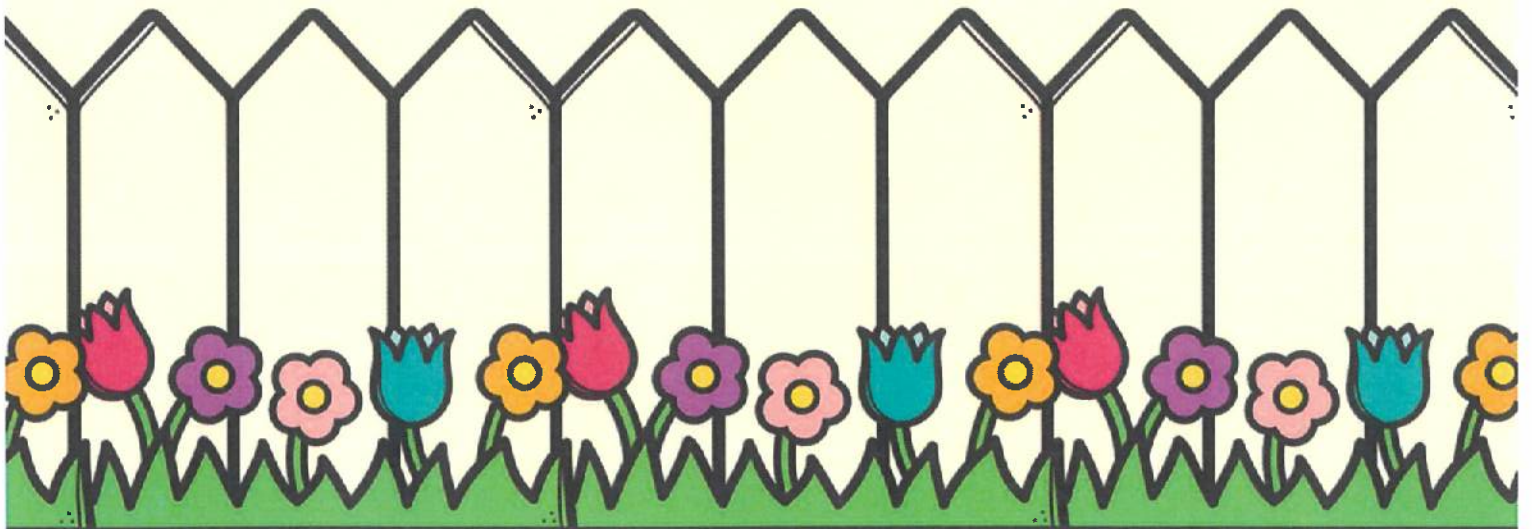


# Welcome To Kindergarten

## **Pastor Appreciation**

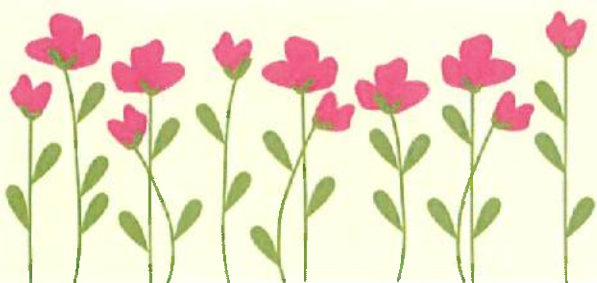
Our kindergarten class will do a pastor appreciation project in February. We will be making goodie bags for each students' pastor to take on that coming Sunday.

## **Grading Policy**

The first nine weeks all students will receive satisfactory or improvement grades. The second nine weeks I will start taking letter grades. Bible grades are based on their memory verse each week. The reading homework does affect your child's reading grade. All grades are based on graded papers.

## **Classroom Snacks**

We will have a class snack bin that the kids will get to choose out from for each snack time. I do ask that each student brings snacks for the whole class every OTHER week. If we need something sooner, I will let you know on group me.

### **Folders**

Tuesday folder from the school will be blue and will need to be returned the next following day. We will have our own class folders I will try to send them every other day with the work they have completed.

### **Water Bottles and Blankets**

Please send blankets and water bottles every Monday. I will have a water bottle station and students will have access to it daily when necessary. All blankets will need to fit in their backpacks and cubies. I will send these home every Friday to be cleaned and brought back the following Monday.



## Discipline Plan

### A Colorful Way to Track Behavior!

A rainbow behavior chart uses colors to help students see how they are doing each day. Each student has a clothespin or marker with their name, and they move it up or down the chart based on their actions.

### How It Works

Everyone starts on green. Good choices move you up the chart, and poor choices move you down. The goal is to finish the day as high as possible!

### Colors and What They Mean

- Purple: Happy Box Reward!
- Blue: You can do it!
- Green: Keep going!
- Pink: Ready to learn! (everyone starts here)
- Yellow: think about it!
- Orange: Warning!
- Red: time out from recess

### Why Use It?

- Lets students know how they're doing right away
- Encourages good choices
- Easy for everyone to understand

The rainbow behavior chart is a simple way to help students recognize and improve their behavior each day.
