
# Western Oklahoma Christian School

# DISCIPLINE PLAN

We will utilize a clip up/down behavior chart in class. Each day the child is in a 'ready to learn' clip, depending on actions, they will be clipped up for good behavior, or down for bad behavior/choices. They have the possibility of moving up or down throughout the day as they make choices. At the end of the day, depending on where they end on the chart, they'll be rewarded with a sticker for their chart and a small piece of candy at dismissal. If a student is absent, they will simply get an A on their chart, it won't count against their behavior stickers to get into the treasure box on Friday. If they end the day clipped down for bad behaviors, they will get an X. Each Friday, students who have received stickers or A's for all 5 days will get into the treasure box! If we have weeks with NO X's the entire class will be rewarded as a whole at teacher's discretion. One x indicates student pick of treasure, two indicates teachers pick of treasure. I will not send charts home or contact you over typical pre-k behavior.

#### WATER BOTTLES/BLANKETS

Every Monday your child will need to bring a water bottle with their name on it and a blanket for nap time. I will send blankets and water bottles home on Fridays to be washed. Please remember to wash them over the weekend and send them back on Monday!

#### **SNACKS**

Each student needs to bring his/her own morning and afternoon snack. You may send a week's worth at a time for them to store in their cubbies. Please send a balanced snack! Let's encourage them to try new foods and varieties! If you can send a protein packed snack this will help their bellies stay fuller longer, helping them to be prepared to learn and play! I do have a mini fridge that I can store smaller quantities of items (cheese sticks, small servings of fruits or vegetables). Healthy suggestions include pretzels, apple sauce pouches, protein bars, cheese sticks, fruits, vegetables, goldfish, graham crackers.

### FIELD TRIPS

We will have 4 field trips this year. Parents are always encouraged to attend if possible. You will receive details before each event at least 2 weeks in advance. If you are unable to attend, you will be required to send your child's booster seat with them to school that day. One field trip will be farm based; another will be at Clinton Public Library.
